

Our **K-6 program** will meet every other week, 5:45-7:00 pm beginning in September through April. We use a classroom model with a curriculum that includes supplemental technology opportunities. The lesson plans are supplied and there is minimal prep work (about 1-2 hours before each class) each week. **We will need one lead teacher and one helper or two co-lead teachers in each classroom.** Most grades will be split into two groups so that the average class size is 6-8 students.

K-6 Lead Catechist: Responsible for preparing and teaching each session (lesson plans provided). Maintain classroom management. Will have a classroom helper (another adult or high school student) to help with activities.

K-6 Co-Catechist: Responsible for preparing and teaching lessons with another adult catechist. Co-catechist classrooms will not have a classroom helper. Both are responsible for maintaining classroom management.

K-6 Classroom Helper: Helper should be high school or older; help catechist with activities during each session. Will not be responsible for teaching.

Our **Middle School (7-8)** and **High School (9-12)** program will meet every other week (opposite of K-6), 6:45-8:00 pm, beginning in September through April. We use a Youth Ministry/Youth Group model (Lifeteen) that is a combination of activity, faith sharing, and small group discussion (and also food!). **Both Middle School and High School each need a team of 6-8 adults that will take turns leading and helping each week.** There is minimal prep work required (about 1-2 hours before each session). Teams will meet at the beginning of each semester to plan the sessions and determine their responsibilities. All materials will be supplied.
